Duties and Responsibilities:

- (a) Report to work station as per hours as outlined in your offer of employment.

- (c) Ensure that material is picked off or left on the process line as instructed. If unsure review with line supervisor the procedure.
- (d) Ensure that material flow is kept and any issues are brought to the Supervisor's attention.
- (e) Work stations are to be kept clean of all debris, area around work station is kept in an orderly manner.
- (f) When system is down it is the responsibility of the sorter to clean his/her work station area.
- (g) Follow all procedures with regard to hazardous material found on the line. Report all such occurrences to supervisor immediately.
- (h) Assist in the cleaning of the facility as needed and instructed by Supervisor.
- (i) Other duties may be assigned with operational changes
